- 3. Understand how the organization deals with failure and appreciates learning.
 - a. How do people fail in your organization?
 - b. Why do people fail in your organization?
 - c. What does the organization do when a person fails?
- 4. Understand how decisions are made.
 - a. Who makes decisions for the organization?
 - b. How are decisions made in the organization?
 - c. How are decisions affecting the organization communicated?
 - d. When are they communicated?
- 5. Understand the organizational leadership.
 - a. How do people describe your leadership style?
 - b. How would you describe your leadership style?
